2.1. Natural geographical and climate conditions

Geographical information: The city is located in the centre of Eastern Europe on the banks of the Dnieper River



The Dnieper River is the fourth longest river in Europe and the third largest river basin area in Europe with the longest river flow in Ukraine

2.2. Demography


Migration movement of the population in 2019



In accordance with the Kyiv City Development Strategy Until 2025, a priority of Kyiv city growth is the development of service sector and innovative industries with high added value:

- IT and communication
- Pharmacy and medical technologies
- Logistics
- Commercial trading
- Engineering and precision machined products industry

- Tourism

Over the last few years, Kyiv contributes more than 20% of Ukraine's GDP

2.7. Foreign economic activity

Kyiv`s foreign trade in goods in 2020:

Exports – 12,447.8 million USD (25.3% of the total of Ukraine) Imports – 22,973.6 million USD (42.5% of the total of Ukraine)

- Foreign trade transactions were carried out with partners from 224 countries. Exports of goods per capita is 3,794.2 USD
- The largest partners in foreign trade operations in goods are: Exports: EU-countries 30.5%, China 18.7%, India 8.1%, Netherlands 6.1% Imports: EU-countries 44.1%, China 18.0%, Germany 9.0%
- Kyiv's foreign trade in services in 2020: Exports – 4075.2 million USD (36.5% of the total of Ukraine) Imports – 2564.3 million USD (49.2% of the total of Ukraine)
- Foreign trade transactions were carried out with partners from 201 countries. The largest partners in foreign trade in services are:

 Exports: EU-countries 49.9%, USA 23.8%, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland 10.9%, Germany 7.3%, Cyprus 6.6%

 Imports: EU-countries 62.7%, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland 12.6%, Turkey– 11.2%, Germany 8.7%, Ireland 8.2%, USA 5.4%
- Capital investment in 2020 is 135,9 billion UAH (32.4% of total amount of Ukraine).

 Direct investment (Equity and investment fund shares + Debt instruments) from foreign countries in Kyiv's economy (as of 31 December 2020) 21,786.7 million USD (44.5% of the total of Ukraine)*

2.10. Environmental Protection

The priority of the development of the City of Kyiv is an environmentally friendly and green city. The Central Geophysical Observatory conducts monitoring of air pollution in Kyiv on 16 stationary posts in eight districts of the city.

The development of the separate waste collection system is a part of general strategy of Kyiv to implement the European waste management approach.

In 2019, the pilot projects were launched in Kyiv to separate the collection of solid household waste (up to three thousand containers for separate fractions – plastic, glass).

In Kyiv 100% of the total population is covered by municipal solid waste removal service. A two-container technological scheme of separated collection of household waste has been implemented.

Set of measures for improvement and arrangement of public transport stops in Kyiv

The investor's competitions for attraction of private investors to the renewal of public transport stops' infrastructure were held. According to the results of the competitions, modern constructions will equip 994 current public transport stops. The volume of investment is at least 353 million UAH.

Project Tasks:

- bringing all infrastructure at public transport stops into unified architectural view;
- ensuring the stops are maintained in appropriate technical and sanitary condition;









- providing lightning, installing trash cans, an alarm button and an electronic dashboard at each stop;
- providing comfortable conditions for people with disabilities.



3.2. Strategic Projects

CABLE CAR LINE WITH PUBLIC FACILITIES

The project envisages the construction of the first phase of the three cable car stations (Poshtova Ploshcha sq., Druzhby Narodiv Arch, Trukhaniv Island) with total length of 1.1 km.

Capacity: 2400 people/hour

Number of cabs: 30-50 (depending on the load)

Cabs capacity: 8-12 people

Indicative number of passengers: 2-5 million /year

Number of support constructions of cablecar: 9

Approximate project budget: 520 million UAH

Estimate:

The project's implementation will contribute to the development of investment potential, improvement of transport and tourist infrastructure and creation of a favorable investment climate in Kyiv.

ARRANGEMENT OF THE AMUSEMENT PARK ON THE TERRITORY OF HYDROPARK (VENETIAN ISLAND)

Project description

The Project envisages the creation of a modern amusement and leisure park on the territory of Hydropark with estimated area of 25 ha. The concept of amusement park on Venetian Island is the first and unique concept of such park in Kyiv. Construction of capital structures on the territory of the arrangement is prohibited. The arrangement of the investment object

(its components) is carried out by installing only prefabricated temporary structures, without the construction of the foundations. Installation of attractions is carried out by the current legislation of Ukraine. The arrangement of the investment object is carried out without damaging the natural objects located on the Venetian Island.

Location:

The Venetian Island is located in geographical centre of Kyiv. Total area is 150 ha. The Venetian Island has good connection with Left and Right Banks of the Dnieper by road and subway. 33% of the island's area is situated within walking distance (up to 10 minutes) from Hydropark Subway station. Subway station Hydropark has a daily passenger flow of about 8000 people (considering that currently less than 5% of territory is used). There is almost no capital construction on the island. In addition, the island has a potential to become one of the most powerful recreation areas in Kyiv.

Location: Kyiv city, Dniprovskyi district, Venetian Island

Land area: 25 ha

Landowner: municipal property of territorial community of Kyiv

Project implementation customer: municipal institution "Park of Culture and Recreation "Hydropark"

Preparatory (pre-investment) works: municipal enterprise "Kyiv Investment Agency"

Estimated total cost of the project: UAH 1.72 billion

Status:

- The project is included in the list of objects, which require investment attraction
- Kyiv City Council's permission for the land development project over land allotment has been received
- Formulation and approval of the detailed territorial plan.





INDUSTRIAL HUB "KYIV BUSINESS HARBOUR"

Project description: a large-scale project, consisting in the creation of an industrial cluster, wholesale and retail complex, which consolidates production and trading capacities for local production in the city of Kyiv.

Location: Kyiv, Desnyanskyi district, Pukhivska Street




